**ELGIN – RYAN HUDSON**

A very hard working athlete with a great attitude, Ryan led the Comet football team in rushing for the 2007 season with 826 yards on 148 carries and scoring 7 touchdowns. He also had 10 receptions for 146 yards with 1 TD, 3 punt returns for 40 yards, and 7 kick returns for 164 yards. Defensively, the junior was 2nd in tackles with 83, 9 for loss, and 2.5 sacks. Ryan also nabbed 2 interceptions – 1 returned for a touchdown – and 2 fumble recoveries.



**ELGIN – MAGGIE MATHEY**

A senior, Maggie was one of the leaders for the Comet volleyball team both on and off the court. A 3-year letter winner and varsity setter, Maggie set season records with 27 points in a match and tied a record with 8 aces in a match. Her overall stats on the season were: 96% at serve with 145 points and 29 aces; 97% setting with 504 assists; 150 digs, 94% passing; 39 saves; 33 kills; and 4 solo blocks, 8 block assists, and 38 blocks kept in play.



**MARION CATHOLIC – CHRIS GARNOW**

Chris played many roles for the Irish 2007 football team. One of 3 co-captains, Chris was the top wide receiver, best cover man on defense, handled punt and kickoff return duties, and was the long snapper for both field goals and PATs. For his conference-topping 46 receptions and 497 receiving yards the senior was awarded 1st Team All NWCC and Honorable Mention All Central District. Chris also received MCHS MVP and Offensive Back of the Year honors.



**MARION CATHOLIC – HANNAH REIFF**

A 4-year varsity starter, Hannah led the Lady Irish 2007 volleyball team in passing, attacks, kills, and blocks. As a team leader and strongest middle hitter and blocker, the senior's outstanding play has earned her many honors during her high school career. Hannah added to those by netting 1st Team honors for both the NWCC and Central District, and was Runner Up Player of the Year in the NWCC. Hannah also ranks near the top of her class.



**M. HARDING – BRADY GREENWOOD**

Named Defensive Player of the Game 5 times for Harding's gridiron squad, team captain Brady broke 2 school career records: Total Tackles with 265 and Tackles for a Loss with 27. The senior was named 1st Team All Greater Buckeye Conference and 1st Team All Northwest District. He was also a Division I All Ohio 2nd Team selection. Outstanding academically as well, Brady ranks 4th in his class and is a National Honor Society member.



**M. HARDING – KYLEE GREENWOOD**

A setter for the Lady President's volleyball team, Kylee set a school record with 45 assists in a game and had 471 assists on the year. She also led the team in scoring with 181 points. Kylee netted 1st Team All District (1 point from Player of the Year), and 2nd Team All Conference, Academic All Conference honors, as well as her 2nd varsity letter. Ranked 1st of 350 students, the sophomore is also class president.



**PLEASANT – GRIFFIN CLARK**

Griffin was cited as one of the keys for the Spartans great football season. Offensively at tailback, Griffin rushed for 537 yards on 87 carries, had 15 catches for 186 yards, and scored 9 touchdowns. Defensively from the free safety position, he had 115 tackles, 1 sack, and 5 interceptions. A team captain who led by example both on and off the field, Griffin collected 1st Team MOAC defensive back and 2nd Team All District honors.



**PLEASANT – ASHLEY ANDREWS**

The exemplary play by Ashley at setter for the Lady Spartan volleyball team was a big part of their success. On the year, Ashley had 117 kills, 1,685 total set attempts with 656 assists (99.1% setting percentage), 179 digs, 75 blocks, and 38 aces while at serve 280 times. For her accomplishments, the junior was selected 1st Team All MOAC, MOAC Player of the Year, 1st Team Central District, Central District Player of the Year, and 1st Team All Ohio.



**RIDGEDALE – CALEB SWISHER**

A 3-year letter winner in cross country for the Rockets, Caleb's hard work on the course resulted in his being named MOAC All Conference Honorable Mention. The junior placed in the top 25 at Districts and set a personal best record of 18:24. He also received medals at the Fredericktown and the Buckeye Central invitationals. A well-rounded scholar athlete, Caleb works hard in the class room carrying a 4.0 GPA.



**RIDGEDALE – TIFFANY BOWMAN**

Tiffany played an important role for the Lady Rocket volleyball team. She led the team in serving at 229 attempts, 4 errors, and 15 aces for 98%. Tiffany also led the team in total points at 115. She dished out 115 assists, had 134 digs, and was 89% at the net with 90 kills. The senior was voted 2nd Team Central District and earned a spot on the 2nd Team Mid-Ohio Athletic Conference.



**RIVER VALLEY – AUSTIN JACOB**

A junior, Jacob hit his stride with the Viking cross country team by mid-season leading his team with a 26th place finish at the Pickerington and a 17th place finish at the Harding invitationals. At the MOAC meet, Austin led all Marion County runners with a 6th-place finish earning 1st Team All Conference with a career personal best time of 17:29. He also earned All District honors at the Central District meet for the 2nd year and helped his team qualify for the Regionals.



**RIVER VALLEY – LACEY LAUER**

Health concerns plagued Lacey early in the year and consideration was given to leaving the Viking cross country team. Through grit and determination, Lacey came back strong and – for the 3rd year in a row – earned 1st Team All Conference at the MOAC meet and All District honors at the Central District meet. The senior took 15th place at Regionals, which helped her team qualify for the State meet where Lacey set her career personal best time with a 20:09.
