ELGIN – **SHAUN O' DONNELL**

Shaun has earned 4 varsity football letters, is a team captain, and a cornerstone on both offense and defense playing fullback, linebacker, and kick-off specialist for the Comets. Offensively, he's racked up 453 rushing yards, including 10 rushing touchdowns, and 72 yards on 4 catches. Defensively, Shaun has 10 solo tackles, 14 assisted tackles, and a tackle behind the line of scrimmage.



ELGIN – **ASHLEY SCHULTZ**

Senior Ashley has provided consistent leadership as a 3-year letterman at the setter position for the Lady Comet volleyball team. During September, she led her team to a 12-4 (9-0 MOAC) record. The scholar athlete leads her team in serving (189 of 191, including 8 aces and 96 points), setting (1179 of 1187, 99%, with 420 assists) and saves (21), and also has 19 blocks, 123 digs, 98% passing, and 7 kills



MARION CATHOLIC – **BROC HURT**

Broc was dominating on both sides for the Irish football team leading them to a 3-1 record in September. Offensively at fullback, Broc rushed for 260 yards on 52 carries and scored 2 TDs. He is also an important blocker for his tailback and quarterback. Defensively, Broc averaged 8 tackles per game as a linebacker. This senior's physical presence and natural instincts on the field can be game altering.



MARION CATHOLIC – **STEPHANIE PFEIFER**

Stephanie, a senior, is a true leader both on and off the court with a 'go hard or go home' attitude that makes her an asset to the Fighting Irish volleyball team. Serving at 83% with 14 aces and 53 total points scored, Stephanie sports a 76% serve receive percentage, 80% passing with 27 digs, 80% attacks with 39 kills, and 10 blocks. She has become the 'go to' person in both the front and back rows.



MARION HARDING – **AARON PITTS**

As captain of the President's football team, Aaron is earning his 3-year award. September saw the senior quarterback complete 56 of 104 passes for 700 total yards with 10 TDs. He also had 150 yards rushing on 40 attempts. Heavily recruited by a number of colleges, Aaron is a scholar athlete (10th in his class of 337) with a great work ethic on and off the field.



MARION HARDING – **KELSEY OSBOURNE**

Senior captain of the Lady President's tennis team, Kelsey finished the season with an overall record of 14-8. A district qualifier, she was selected as a 1st Team Greater Buckeye Conference member in second singles. A leader both on and off the court, Kelsey is a scholar athlete who ranks 5th in her class of 337 and was also chosen 1st Team Greater Buckeye Conference All Academic.



PLEASANT – **TREVOR HARRIS**

Trevor had a near perfect first 5 games for the Spartan football team. The senior quarterback completed 47 of 66 passes for 875 yards – a 71.2% completion rating – and averaging 175 yards per game. He also tossed for 15 touchdowns with no interceptions. Trevor is a leader both on and off the field.



PLEASANT – **ERIN KUME**

Senior co-captain Erin helped the Lady Spartan volleyball team to a very successful start. A consistent player providing leadership, in 17 matches Erin made 268 of 288 attacks with 157 kills, 85 digs with 13 saves, and 122 blocks with 71 solo and 51 assists. Erin had a 93% hitting efficiency, was 88% in serving with 12 aces, 100% in setting, 95% in passing and 96% in service receives.



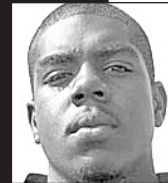
RIDGEDALE – **KYLE TANNYHILL**

Kyle is a running back for the Ridgedale football team. During the first 5 games of the year, he racked up 409 yards on 69 carries. Kyle also had 3 receptions for a total of 31 yards. Only a sophomore, the young Rocket scored 5 touchdowns, which came as 4 rushing and 1 reception against Highland, River Valley, and North Union. As a PAT kicker, Kyle is a perfect 6 for 6.



RIDGEDALE – **ECHO GATTSHALL**

Echo has been a steady middle hitter/blocker for the Lady Rocket volleyball team through September. Playing well at the net, she has compiled 154 kills and 53 block kills, plus 104 blocks kept in play. Developing into a strong server, Echo has also scored 76 points. A National Honor Society student, the senior takes college classes one-half of each day as part of Ridgedale's PSEO program.



RIVER VALLEY – **ARLO STERLING**

A senior co-captain, Arlo entered the 2004 season with a new attitude. He has done a fantastic job of leading the Viking football team as a positive force despite their 1 and 4 start. Refusing to allow other team members to get down or be lazy, Arlo has run for 856 yards in 99 attempts with 7 touchdowns. He also has made 21 tackles, 6 assists, and 2 interceptions.



RIVER VALLEY – **JESSICA CASTLE**

Jessica is a middle hitter for the Lady Viking volleyball team, leading them to September records of 11-5 overall and 6-1 league. A tremendous leader, Jessica posted stats of 91% (156 of 171) at serving with 11 aces, 90% (238 of 265) at serve receive, 86% (125 of 146) passing, and 83% (283 of 341) hitting. She also had 138 kills, 39 blocks, and 75 digs.
